Good Afternoon Parents and Guardians,

In an effort to keep you informed, I want to make you aware that on Thursday of last week the South Central Public Health Department increased the Regional Risk level for Twin Falls county from yellow (moderate risk) to orange (high risk). The health department does this every two weeks by county in an effort to keep people living within their jurisdiction informed. Moving from yellow to orange is based on three factors:

- #1 Positivity rate
- #2 Average new cases per 10,000 residents
- #3 Hospital capacities

In speaking with our health district officials about this recent change, our district can and should look at the community of Hansen and our school district conditions to determine what level we are in. With the amount of activity going on within our school district at this time, we will be staying in the "yellow" category. Our school board revisits our COVID protocol and local conditions at every board meeting and if needed, will call a special meeting to address any needed changes.
